PREVENTING TRIPS AND SLIPS

Wet floors, spills and excess clutter can mean disaster for construction employees working in an already dangerous environment. Keep these safety tips in mind to prevent injuries on the job:

- Keep floors clean and dry at all times.
- Remove excess clutter from aisles, exits and passageways.
- Tie all extension cords above head to avoid running cords down hallways. This will avoid a slip and trip hazard.
- If you do spill something on the ground, clean the spill up as quickly as possible. Let others know of the spill and put up a barrier until it is cleaned up.
- Alert your supervisor if you notice missing hole covers, guardrails that have damage, or any other fall protection that is missing to prevent accidents.
